Odds & Ends: Just a reminder, generally you are permitted to cancel an event up to 7:00pm of the day before the event. However, to do so you must notify either Don Whalen or Marty Owen. Check the 2008 Golf Policy Letter, posted on our website, for a complete statement on cancellation procedures.

Don't Call Us (or the Course) We'll Call You: A decision on whether to cancel an event due to inclement weather is generally not made before the morning of the event. When an event is cancelled, Don Whalen, Gary Bohn and I will call everyone on the pairings sheet at least one hour before the first tee time. Remember we don't cancel on the forecast of inclement weather or when there are light rains (not just a drizzle). On inclement weather days, be sure to check the website for a revised check-in cut-off, it will generally be around the first tee time. Groups will be put out on a first-come basis.

2008 Match Play: Listed in your March Sign-Up sheet is "Match Play Registration". If you would like to enter this year's competition you must sign-up and pay the \$10 registration fee. Should more than 64 players sign-up, there will be a Match Play Qualifier on the April 29th at the Mather weekly event. The low 64 nets will qualify for the 2008 Match Play.
