The team with Gary Schanz, Norm Maulsby, Tom May and Mike Anderson were the winners and are scheduled to play in the State SIR Scramble at Poppy Ridge G.C. in Livermore on Monday August 11, 2008. They will be representing SIR Area 9 and SIR 102 in this State SIR event. Congratulations to this team even though they tied the second place but won by there higher handicap.

On the Individual SIR State Qualifier for Poppy Hills this SIR Division tournament will be played at Butte Creek Country Club in Chico CA. on August 18, 2008.
