The Right Organization for You ?

SIR is a Northern California retired men's organization founded in 1958 and with over 26,000 members enjoying mutual fellowship while promoting our goal of **“dignity and independence in retirement”**. SIR is open to all retired men regardless of age, race or religion.

No dues, no hassle, no flipping pancakes or raising money, just breaking bread once a month with retirees who don't have to prove themselves and enjoy our activities such as:

- Fishing

Our Program:

SIR Branch #102 has over 150 golf club members and average about 80 participants in each of our events.

Weekly: We schedule an event at least 50 weeks of the year, usually on Thursday, on some of the best Sacramento area courses and play light rain or shine. As a SIR Branch #102 member, you may choose to play in any or all of the events. You may also sign up as either a single or with other Club Members. The Tournament Director will automatically pair you with others to complete four man groups and give you the opportunity to meet other members. The Tournament Director also assigns everyone to one of four Flights based on handicap so that you are competing against players of similar skill level. We try to stage one or two team events each month. Nearly all our competitions are based on individual net scores. Our Handicap Chairman posts the adjusted scores with the NCGA.

The Club also conducts an annual medal play Club Championship and Match Play Championship.

Other Tournaments: Our Branch also arranges for a number of additional over-night or longer golfing trips. One highlight of the year is the two-day /three-night outing to Carson City.

SIR State Tournaments: The State Golf Committee conducts tournaments of one to four days. These take place in Las Vegas, Reno, Mexico and locally in the Valley. The culmination of all SIR tournaments takes place at Poppy Hills in Pebble Beach in late October.

NCGA Handicap: (\$35)

One of the great advantages of being a SIR golfer is that we will provide an NCGA GHIN number, required to play in club tournaments, for only **\$35** per year. Many associate men's clubs cost a minimum of \$75 per year and some up to \$150, just to belong to the club and get your card. With your membership you are entitled to attend a no additional cost our Annual Awards Banquet held each November. We are determined to provide quality golf at low prices.

Your Commitment: New Members

A major requirement from our members is that they attend our monthly lunch meetings. We meet for lunch at the
